

HOW TO USE MD10 CONDITIONER



1. Preparation of Conditioner


To make "1 Litre (1,000ml)" of Diluted Conditioner

***40g (40ml) for Super Volume & Spanish Water Dog**

***30g (30ml) for Silky Smooth & Texture Volume**

***20g (20ml) for Super Hydration Conditioner**

A Clean plastic bottle with secure top will be ideal. Or A Jug with a whisk to mix it really well with small amount of hot water.



Measured Conditioner into a bottle OR a jug with small amount (e.g 100ml) of relatively HOT water. Mix vigorously ensuring no globules remain. Finally **add more water making a total of 1 Litre.**

Please make sure the measurement is correct and **NEVER thicker than the amount directed above.** If you make it too thick, you may find unwanted results such as an over hydrated and dull coat. In that case, rinse the coat lightly with warm water. No shampoo needed.

If you find that even the suggested ratio results in the coat being too Sticky, Dull (NO shine) or cloggy, please DILUTE FURTHER to suit the individual dog's coat. Thinner is better than too thick - Some dog needs less conditioner.

2. After shampooing the dog using MD10, apply the conditioner where you would like to achieve the desired effect. For example, all over the body, or just specific parts. For SWD, Spray the conditioner on damp coat, OR apply all over but lightly rinse off.

To apply in the targeted area, e.g. only head, only beard, a FINE MIST SPRAY can be used, which is very useful to control the amount as well. Diluted conditioner in a spray bottle can also be used as a Grooming Spray.

3. Massage the conditioner into dog's coat, OR comb through. Squeeze out the excess water from the dog's coat, then blow dry or dry naturally depending on the breed and coat type.
